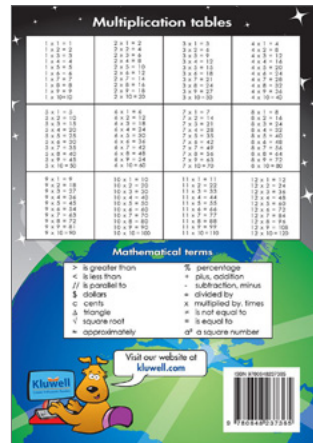
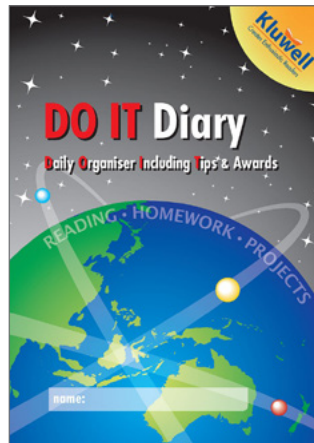
Ollie's Treasure is an additional title by the *Lessons of a LAC* duo. It is a tale of mindfulness for young, developing minds.
