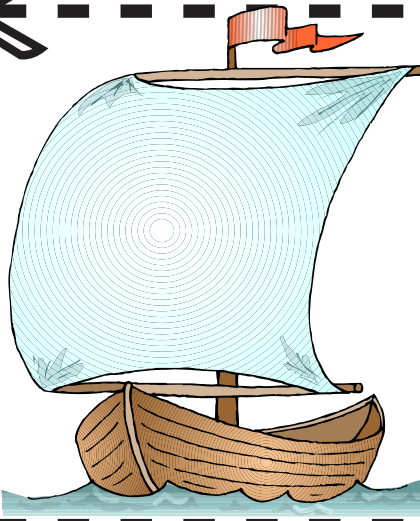


WRITING STARTERS
