

# Bostik Volcano



## WHAT YOU WILL NEED



Plastic bottle



Bostik Clag Paste



Bostik Craft PVA Glue



Plastic Mixing Bowl



Newspaper



Knife



Paint brushes



Thick Cardboard  
(50cm x 50cm)



Scissors



Craft Paint



Dinosaur Figurines



Red Food Colouring  
(5-10 drops)



White Vinegar  
(1 cup)



Baking Soda  
(2-3 tsp)

Adult supervision required when using a knife

## Bostik Volcano

### STEP 1



Get a teacher to help you cut the top and bottom off the plastic bottle.

### STEP 2



Use Bostik Craft PVA Glue to stick the plastic bottle to the centre of the cardboard. Make sure the plastic bottle is upright.

### STEP 3



Shred the newspapers into long strips. Empty Bostik Clag into a bowl. This will make the glue easier to apply.

### STEP 4



To begin building the volcano, scrunch strips of paper into balls, apply clag and stick them around the base of the bottle. Repeat this step, working your way around and up the bottle to form a base for the papier mâché.

## Bostik Volcano



### STEP 5



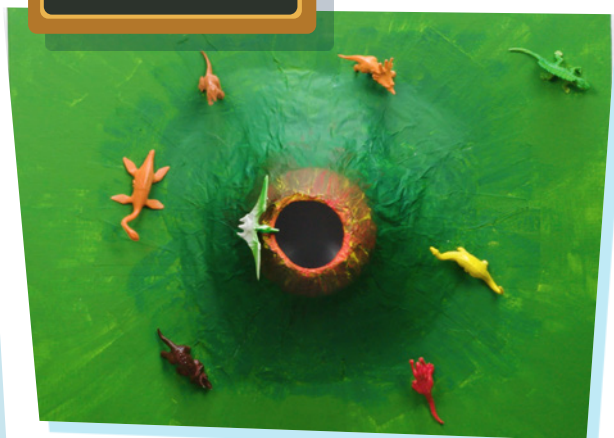
Next, dip a long strip of paper into the glue and lay it on the crumpled-up paper – from the top of the bottle to the bottom. Continue this process until the entire volcano is covered! Repeat step 5 twice – you'll need at least three layers of paper! Leave the volcano to dry for 48 hours.

### STEP 6



Paint the volcano.

### STEP 7



Decorate the volcano with dinosaurs!

### STEP 8



Take your volcano outside! **This could get messy!**



#### Make Your Volcano Erupt.

Pour the baking soda into the top of the volcano. Add the red food colouring to the white vinegar and tip it into the volcano. Watch it erupt!
