Thick Cardboard (50cm x 50cm)

Red Food Colouring (5-10 drops) **Dinosaur Figurines**

White Baking Vinegar Soda (1 cup) (2-3 tsp)

Get a teacher to help you cut the top and bottom off the plastic bottle.



Shred the newspapers into long strips. Empty Bostik Clag into a bowl. This will make the glue easier to apply.

Use Bostik Craft PVA Glue to stick the plastic bottle to the centre of the cardboard. Make sure the plastic bottle is upright.



To begin building the volcano, scrunch strips of paper into balls, apply clag and stick them around the base of the bottle. Repeat this step, working your way around and up the bottle to form a base for the papier mâché.









Next, dip a long strip of paper into the glue and lay it on the scrunched-up paper - from the top of the bottle to the bottom. Continue this process until the entire volcano is covered! Repeat step 5 twice - you'll need at least three layers of paper! Leave the volcano to dry for 48 hours.



Paint the volcano.



Decorate the volcano with dinosaurs!



Make Your Volcano Erupt. Pour the baking soda into the top of the volcano. Add the red food colouring to the white vinegar and tip it into the volcano. Watch it erupt!
