PROJECT SHEET

CUT TRIANGLES INTO THE SIDES FOR MORE DEFINED PETALS.

STEP 1. CUT EGG CARTON



Cut off the small knobs sticking up in between the egg cups - these will be the smaller blooms. Cut each of the egg cups out as well.

STEP 2. PAINT AND DRY



Paint all of the egg cups and small knobs, front and back with pink paint. Allow them to dry completely.

STEP 3. PREP PIPE CLEANERS



Thread pipe cleaners through blooms and secure the end with a pony bead. Snip carton edges to create petals.

STEP 4. DESIGN AND SECURE



Wrap the long end of the pipe cleaners around the branch. Bunch flowers into groups of three and secure with a hot glue gun.
