PROJECT SHEET

CUT BROWN PAPER TO SIZE SO IT IS THE SAME LENGTH AS CARDBOARD ROLL

STEP 1. TELL YOUR STORY



Use glitter glue to draw Aboriginal-inspired symbols on brown paper.

STEP 2. ROLL ON



Once dry, paste onto the cardboard roll with a Glu Stick.

STEP 3. MAKE THE ENDS



Cut two circles out of brown paper. If you like, add a fringe on the outside of the circle.

STEP 4. SECURE YOUR RAINSTICK



Secure one circle onto the end of the cardboard roll with a rubber band.

PROJECT SHEET

EXPERIMENT WITH PIPE CLEANERS, CRAFT WIRE & COFFEE BEANS TO CHANGE THE SOUND!

STEP 5. TWIST FOIL



Tear foil and twist into a stick-like shape.

STEP 6. CREATE A COIL



Wrap the twisted foil around a wooden spoon and remove to reveal a spiral shape. Place in rainstick.

STEP 7. ADD EXTRA SOUND



Pour some rice into the rainstick using a funnel for extra sound.

STEP 8. SEAL YOUR RAINSTICK



Fasten the other end of the rainstick with a rubber band.

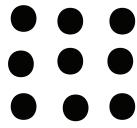

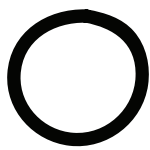

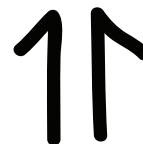
