

World Environment Day Lesson Plan

LAYERS OF THE EARTH

AIM:

To create a world using modelling clay to commemorate World Environment Day.

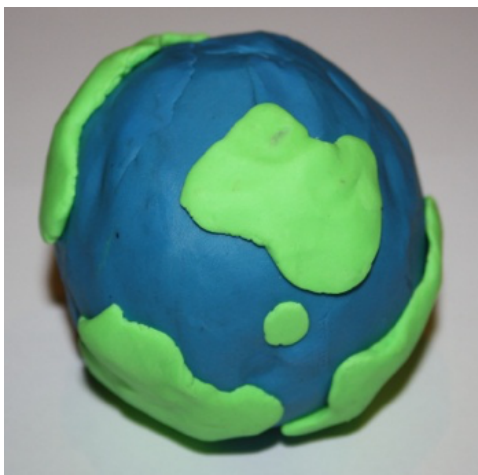
MATERIALS NEEDED:

- Plasticine:
126584 Bright Blue, 126591 Green, 130536 Brown,
126775 Yellow, 126614 Orange, 126577 Red
- A plastic knife or spatula for slicing
- Or get all the colours in the Plasticine class pack: 132196



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Lay out all the colours of the Plasticine in order: Red, Orange, yellow, black (or brown), blue then green.
 2. Roll a small amount of red Plasticine into a ball about the size of a golf ball.
 3. Using the orange Plasticine, form a layer around the outside of the red ball about 1-2cm thick.
 4. Repeat these steps for yellow, black and blue. You should now have a blue ball and not see any other colours – YET!
 5. Flatten some green Plasticine with a roller then cut out some pieces for the land, then place them in different spots onto the blue.
- Your ball should now look like this:



6. Now for the best part – take your plastic knife and cut the ball in half...
