

Make your own Jellyfish Mobile

AIM:

To create awareness amongst children about safety at the beach.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- 2 medium styrofoam balls cut in half (105435)
- Various coloured pipecleaners (104704, 102205,106388, 106364)
- Paint & paintbrushes
- Wool or string
- Wooden skewer
- Darning needle
- Moving eyes (103790)
- Pencil
- Glue
- Scissors

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Cut styrofoam balls in half (get an adult to help you do this).
- 2. Paint styrofoam balls.
- 3. Use skewer to poke hole through middle of ball (get an adult to help you do this).
- 4. Tie a knot in one end of wool and put through the hole from bottom to top. Tie the top end of wool to the coathanger.
- 5. Wrap pipecleaners around pencil to form spiral and push into bottom of styrofoam balls.
- 6. Glue moving eyes to front of each ball.

DISCUSSION:

- 1. When or where have you ever seen a jellyfish?
- 2. Some jellyfish can sting you, what other creatures might hurt you at the beach?
- 3. What can you do to make sure you don't get hurt?
