

Progresso Graphite Pears and Oil

IDEA!

Teach students about sketching and tonal art techniques using Koh-I-Noor Progresso Graphite Pencils.

This exercise is suitable for students of all ages.

You'll need...

- 2B or 4B Koh-I-Noor Progresso Graphite Pencil
- Roymac Rains™ Watercolour Paper- 300 gsm
- Roymac Achiever Brush Set
- Vegetable Oil



1. Sketch your design - start lightly plotting in the shape of the pear and then add some shading to one side.



2. Darken the tone until you're happy with the amount of shading.



3. Dip your brush into the vegetable oil and "scumble" over the surface of the graphite to blend. This will make a grungy, artistic effect.



4. Taking your pencil you can then touch up your artwork by drawing over it again, adding more shading.

Here's a Tip or two!

- Use an oil and acrylic brush (with long handle coarser bristles)
- To clean off the brush dip in oil and wipe on a paper towel.



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
