



Activity for kids: Chalk Scenes!

Chalk scenes are a fun way to liven up group play! Perfect for a class or group activity, this will get the children outside and creating as a team.

Simply use our Micador early stART Egg Chalk Class Set so each child can contribute to your chalk scene.

Our easy grip egg shaped chalk suits a child's full handed grip, plus it's easy to clean - our chalk disappears with water!



You'll need...

- early stART Egg Chalk Class Set
- Leaves, sticks, flowers, rocks – any interesting foliage you can find!

Let's start...



1. Set The Scene

Decide as a group what scene you will create (e.g. a farm scene). Then let each child choose a chalk egg to draw with.



2. Ready, Set, Sketch!

Ask the children to each draw a part of the scene. For instance you might have children drawing farmers, cows, pigs, chickens and chook nests.



3. Back to Nature

Once the scene has been sketched, ask the students to collect leaves, sticks, bark, stones etc. and use nature to bring the scene to life!



4. Egg-cellent end!

Try and incorporate the egg chalk into your scene. We created a chicken nesting box for the final touch.
