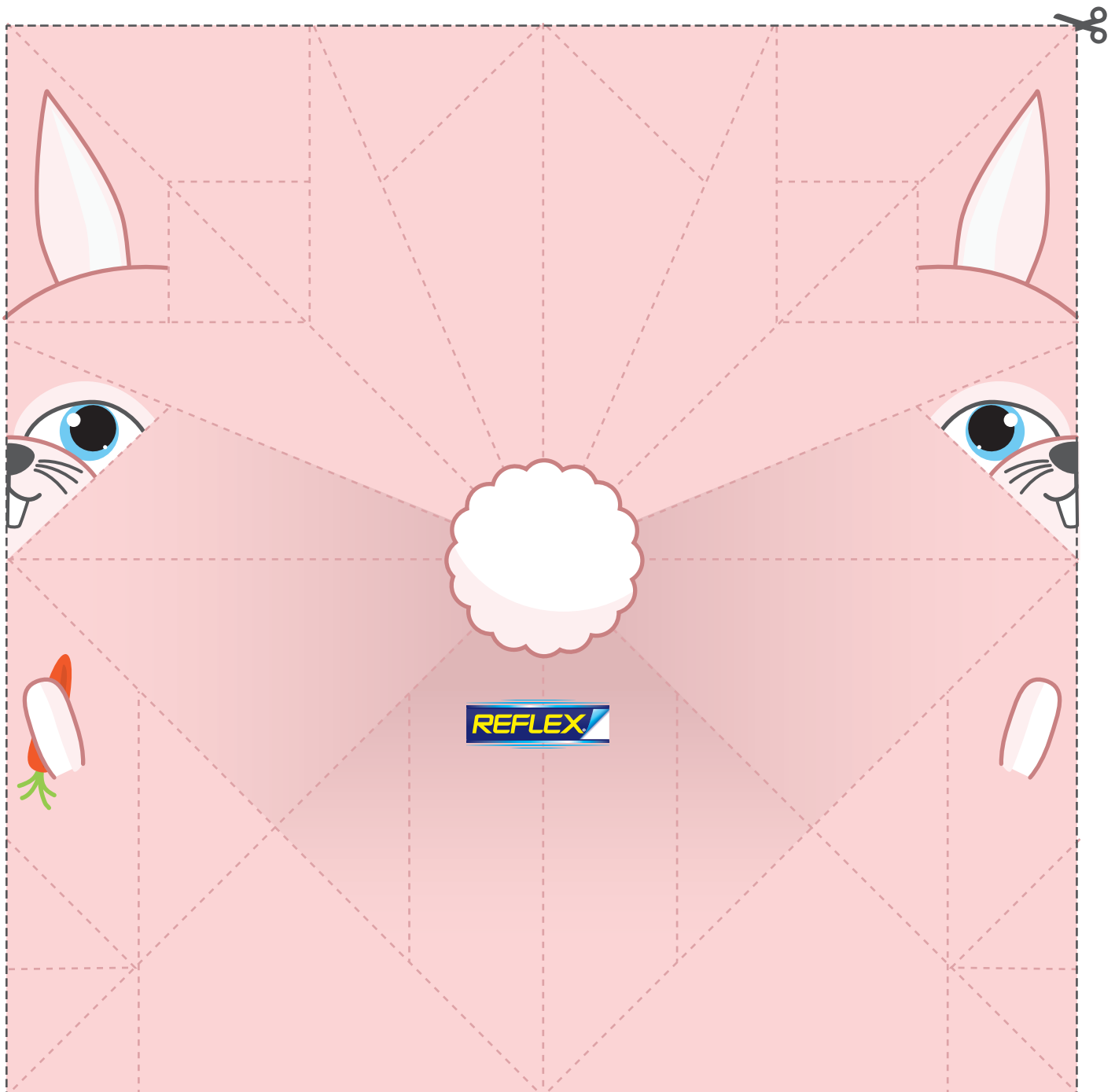
- ✓ Scissors

GETTING STARTED

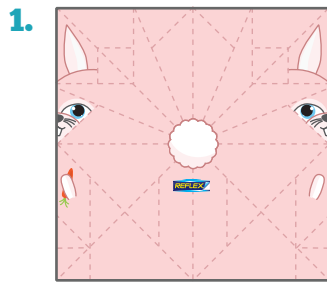
1. Print the template and instructions
2. Carefully cut out the template below (black dashed lines)
3. Then carefully follow the instructions on the next page to make your Easter Bunny



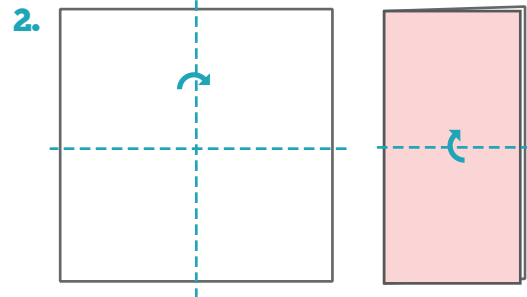
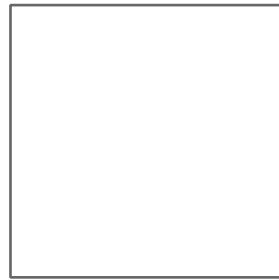
For better performance, always rely on Reflex.

Instructions

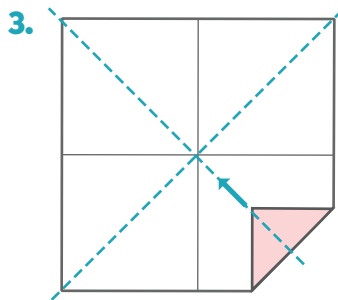
Once you have cut out the template you will have a square. Follow the folding instructions below to make your Easter Bunny.



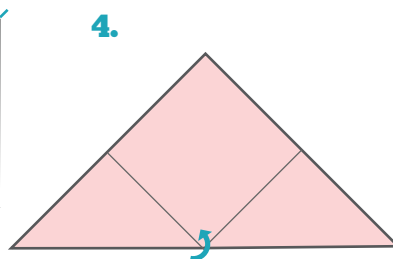
1. Start with the template face up, then turn over to show the blank side.



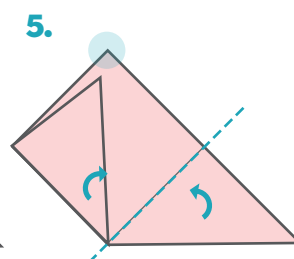
2. Fold in half and then in half again. Crease, then unfold.



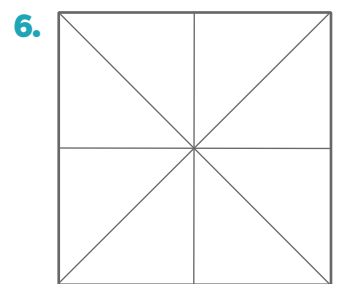
3. Repeat, making diagonal crease lines. Unfold.



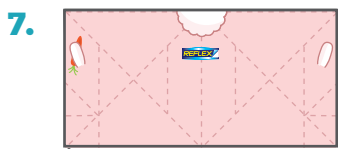
4. Fold in half to create a triangle.



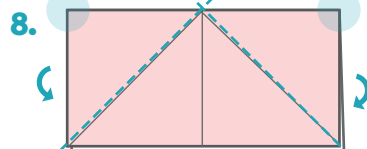
5. Fold the bottom left and right corner to the top point.



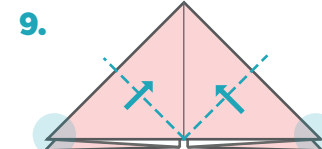
6. Unfold.



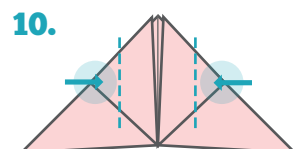
7. Fold in half. Make sure the template is the right way up.



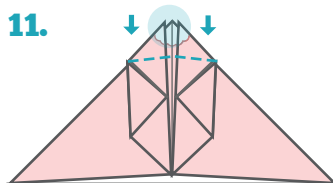
8. Tuck the corners inside the body. So that you create a triangle.



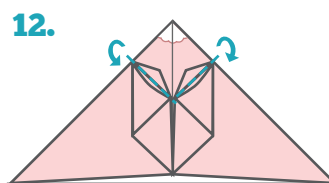
9. Fold the bottom flaps in to meet in the center.



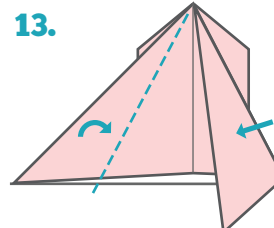
10. Fold the corners to meet in the centre.



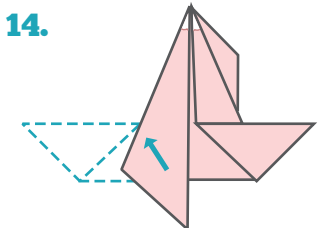
11. Fold the corners of the top layer down.



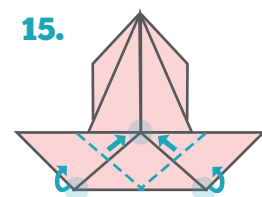
12. Fold into the pocket created. Do this for both of the corners.



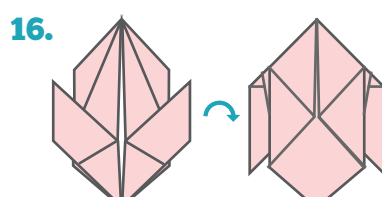
13. Flip over, then fold the sides to the center crease.



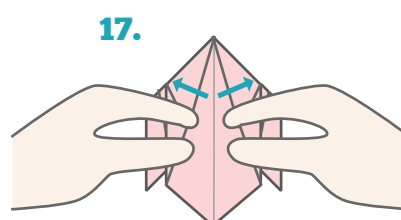
14. Fold the ears out to the sides.



15. Fold in the bottom corners so that the Easter Bunny's face is revealed.



16. Once the ears are complete turn it over to the bottom side.



17. Pull apart the sides to create the base for the bunny to sit on.



18. FINISHED
Flip over and shape the bunny so it will sit.
