

## Interfit Standard Security Cage Installation Instructions

This unit provides a theft deterrent and some protection from incidental impact.

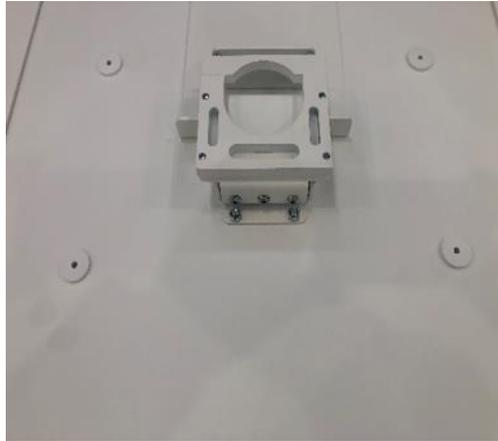
Mount the ceiling post, as usual, using appropriate fixings.

The attachment of the cage to this post uses a disc screwed to the bottom of the post.

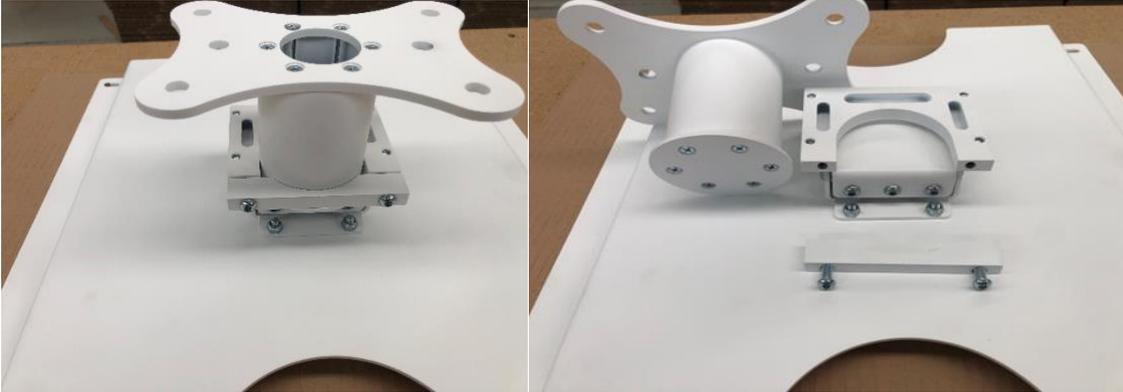
1. Use QTY (6) self-tapping screws into the bottom of the post to attach the disc.



2. Projector Mounting holes are drilled into the top plate, using these holes and washers provided above and below, invert the projector and mount securely using appropriate length screws.



3. To remove the front bars, use an allen key to remove the (2) bolts from the top. The bottom part is connected by a captive nut, unscrew using the bar.
4. The sides and back of the cage are (1) piece and can be removed by loosening the (6) screws inside the cage these are located under the keyhole slots on the top plate.
  - a. After the cage is re-assembled and a projector mounted...
5. To attach the cage to the post, loosen the clamp arrangement and slide the disc on the bottom of the post into the clamp and tighten the (2) M6 bolts. This arrangement allows the cage to rotate if required. After the correct alignment is achieved these bolts need to be tightened securely.



6. The tilt/yaw adjustment is located under this clamp arrangement for final adjustments if required. Lens shift makes this adjustment easy, with most projectors currently supplied



There is a plate provided that can be placed at the top and locked using a padlock.
